


If this is your first time connecting to the DaaS environment, this PowerPoint will show you how to install and set up the remote desktop application so that you will have access to the virtual desktop.


If you have already completed this step, you can skip to Slide 27 to see the process for logging into the DaaS environment upon subsequent logins.


To connect to the DaaS environment on the Windows 10 Operating System, download the zip file by clicking on the link below.


Once the file has been downloaded to your device, you will need to unzip its contents.

This can be done with the extraction tool included with File Explorer.








If you have Smart Screen installed, a pop-up window will appear which will prevent the BAT file from executing.




A Command window will appear and quickly disappear indicating that the BAT file has been successfully executed.


The virtual desktops associated with this workspace will now be displayed.




