Subject: Fluor Marine Propulsion (FMP) Oracle Fusion Cloud – Deployment Update; For Information

As a valued supplier for FMP, we are excited to update you on our Oracle Fusion Cloud (OFC) implementation and provide additional details regarding the deployment. As previously communicated in October via PD-02780, FMP will complete the implementation of OFC in March 2025, offering new features and benefits that will improve our ability to interact with you.

To successfully transition from legacy systems to OFC, FMP will conduct a transition window to temporarily freeze data transactions. Specific transition milestones, dates, actions, and impacts will be communicated in early February. In the interim, you may contact your Contracts Professional or reach out to the Supplier Support Team at [FMPSupplierSupport@unnpp.gov](mailto:FMPSupplierSupport@unnpp.gov) with questions.

### *Supplier Portal*

As an FMP supplier, you are invited to participate in the Oracle Supplier Portal, which will be your one-stop-shop to access real-time information and the ability to transact with FMP through a secure, self-service cloud platform. If you have not already done so, please identify one to two contacts for initial system access setup. To do this, please submit the contact's name and email address to [FMPSupplierSupport@unnpp.gov](mailto:FMPSupplierSupport@unnpp.gov) and your FMP Contracts Professional. In the next several weeks, initial contacts will be established as users in OFC and provided with additional guidance to create their accounts. Suppliers will have the ability to set up additional contacts in the future. Guidance on use of the Supplier Portal will be made available closer to deployment.

To keep our collective business data secure, FMP is implementing multi-factor authentication (MFA) as part of the login requirements. The following MFA methods will be permitted, and you will be able to choose which option best meets your needs:

1. Mobile phone Authenticator Application (e.g., Oracle Mobile Authenticator, Microsoft Authenticator, etc.)

**OR**

2. FIDO (Fast Identity Online) Authenticator (e.g., YubiKey, Windows Hello, Mac Touch ID, etc.)

The contact(s) you provide will need to complete MFA setup to access their account(s) in the Supplier Portal. Additional guidance will be provided in a February communication.
